Sir,

This has reference to your letter dated 18th August, 1999 sending therewith the approval of All India Council for Technical Education for establishment of Vidyalankar Dnyanapeeth Trust's Engineering College, Dadar, Mumbai and permission from the Deputy Secretary, the Higher and Technical Education, Mumbai, permitting therewith to start the College of Engineering in the branches of (1) Information Technology, (2) Electronics Engineering and (3) Computer Engineering with intake capacity of 60 students at each branch from the academic year 1999-2000 and also requesting permission to admit students for the First Year Engineering class in the said branches for the academic year 1999-2000.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that the Vice-Chancellor under the power conferred on her under Section 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 granted permission to your Trust to start the new College of Engineering for the academic year 1999-2000 only, on permanently 'No Grant Basis' and admit students to the First Year Class of Engineering in the branches of (1) Information Technology, (2) Electronics Engineering and (3) Computer Engineering with intake capacity of 60 each through the Centralised Admission Process for the academic year 1999-2000, subject to the fulfilment of the conditions mentioned by the All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi in its letter No.F.No.:740-89-346(E)/ET/99 dated 3rd August, 1999 and the Deputy Secretary, Higher & Technical Education, Government of Maharashtra vide its resolution No.PEC-79/(374/99) Tanshi-1 dated 11th August, 1999 and also the conditions laid down by the University of Mumbai from time to time.
