
Drishti: An Eye for the Lenses!

"Photograph takes an instant out of time, altering life by holding it still."










Marching Towards the Moon








Kabhi Code, Kabhi Decode





A fun event based on the game Escape Room, where a group of students discover clues, solve puzzles and accomplish the given tasks within 10 minutes.




Aaina




Panache

The Musical was based on the theme 'Mumbai Meri Jaan'.


It manifolds many aspects of Mumbai through various performances such as Frolic Dances, Melodic Singing and Dramatic Compositions by the students and faculty of VIT.
