1. Grant Details

The institute applied to All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) in July 2013 for the Upgrade and Modernization of the Embedded Systems, Robotics & Automation (ESRA) laboratory in the Electronics Engineering Department of the Institute, with Prof. Shrikant Velankar as the Coordinator for the Project.

The AICTE evaluated our application and a grant of Rs. 475,000/= was sanctioned under MODROB scheme vide the AICTE File No. 9-217/RIFD/MODROB/Policy – 1/2013-14(Pvt.) dated August 14, 2013. (Henceforth called This MODROB Grant) – (Copy of Sanction letter is attached – Doc. 1)

The Institute has received Rs. 380,000/= on 19/09/2013 (80% amount of the sanctioned grant) through Direct payment transfer to the Institute's account with The Cosmos Co-operative Bank Ltd, Dadar, Mumbai branch (A/C no. 012204301210066) through payment advice no. 1439 dated 19/09/2013. (Copy of Payment Advice is attached – Doc. 2)

The Duration of the Project was 1 Year. The Project has been completed within the prescribed period of 1 year. (Before 19/09/2014) The related purchase, procurement, Installation and commissioning has been completed and the Laboratory equipped with these items has been fully functional.

This report is to provide the Granting authority (AICTE – RIFD) with the complete details of commissioning and utilization of the Grant. Also as the project has been completed within specified time frame, request to release the balance 20% amount due to the Institute, vide this MODROB Grant.

2. Purchase and Procurement

The Purchase and procurement for the material under this MODROB grant was initiated in March 2014. The equipment and vendors were short listed after going through technical details and taking Laboratory Demonstrations of the Material to be purchased.

The Purchase Committee meeting was held on April 28, 2014. The Purchase committee comprised of –

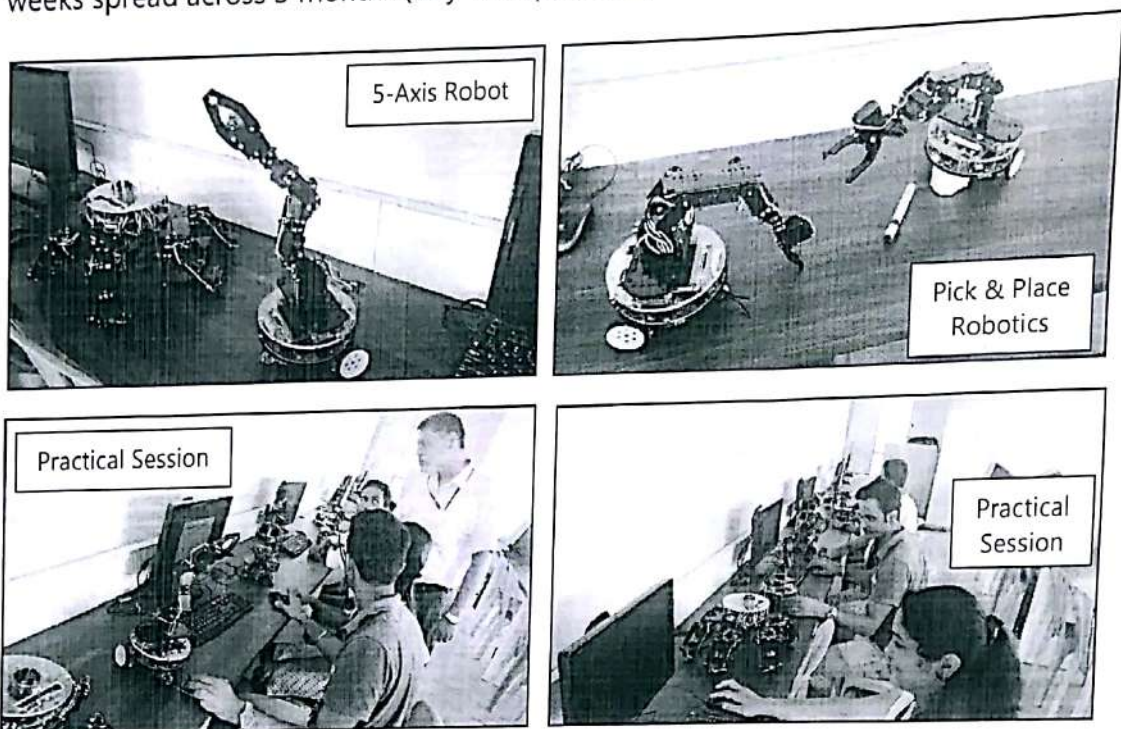
4. Utilization

Regular Utilization of the Hardware equipment and Software tools installed under this MODROBS Grant started in July, 2014 with the commencement of Odd Semesters (2, 4, 6 and 8) of Academic year 2014-15. Following sections detail the utilization of the Equipment purchased under this MODROBS grant, in the Embedded Systems, Robotics & Automation Laboratory.

4.1. Laboratory Sessions of Robotics (Semester VII) – Computer Engineering

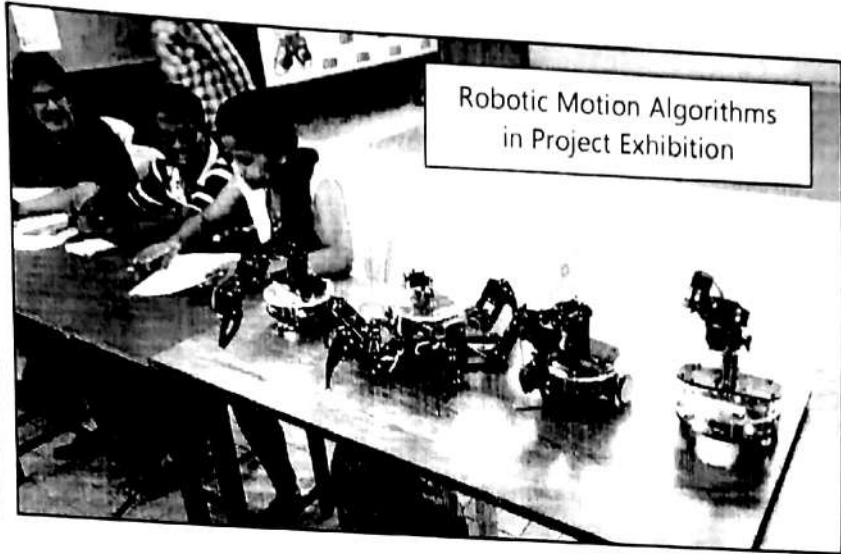
B.E. (Semester VII) in Computer Engineering branch is having a subject named "Robotics & Artificial Intelligence" for which the utilization of material under this MODROB Grant was very widely done. The Laboratory and Practical Assignments of the abovementioned subject were performed using these robots & tools.

The class students were divided in the practical batches of 15 students each. They were given the Robots & tools for hands on work in the group of 3-4 students. The duration of Laboratory was 2 Hours / Week and the semester schedule was for 12 weeks spread across 3 months (July to September, 2014)



4.2. B.E. Final year Project (Semester VII) – Electronics Engineering and Biomedical Engineering

3 Groups from Semester VII – Electronics Engineering and Biomedical Engineering consisting of 12 students have their Final Year Projects based on Robots / Robotic Arms and their Design. They used the 4 and 5 Axis Robots and Logic Analyzer hosted Universal Trainer Development Platform with the Daughter Boards, widely for the implementation of their project work. The Implementation is expected to continue up to March 2014. The work amounts to about 750 Man hours with this Equipment. It is proving extremely useful in robotics related project works and helping in improving the final year B.E. project quality.



4.3. Robotics & automation (Semester VIII) – Electronics Engineering

B.E. (Semester VIII) in Electronics Engineering branch is having a subject named "Robotics and Automation" for which the utilization of material under this MODROB Grant is extremely useful. The Laboratory and Practical Assignments of the abovementioned subject would perform using this equipment, in the semester commencing shortly in December, 2014.

The class student strength of 210 (3 Divisions) would be divided in 4 practical batches of 17 students each per division, to conduct these laboratory sessions where this laboratory and abovementioned equipment as expected to be used heavily.

4.4. Research Papers / Work:

Currently the work is in progress to implement certain algorithms implementing the Adaptive cruise control and swarm robotics using the specified hardware and robotic equipment. A few student groups from Third and Fourth Year Electronics Engineering and Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering, are active on this area under the guidance of Dr. Varsha Turkar, Prof. Akhil Masurkar, Dr. Anjali Deshpande, HOD Electronics and Prof. Shrikant Velankar. The resulting work is being presented in papers in National Conferences held in Maharashtra state during this and next month.

4.5. M.E. Projects


Currently, one robotics based M.E. project is under progress that extensively exploits the resources of these robots and tools. It is intended to implement certain Robot motion Intelligence Algorithms and application in the utility robotics.

5. Future Plans on Utilization

In future, we plan to use these resources made available through this MODROBS Grant, for various activities –

- Subject Laboratories – Robotics, Robotics in Biomedical Engg. Robotics and Automation, Embedded Systems, Embedded Systems and Real Time Programming. (All in the Final Year of Electronics, Electronics & Telecommunications and Biomedical Engineering, branches currently offered at the institute)
- B.E. Projects – Final year Projects in Electronics, Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering and Bio-medical Engineering.
- M.E. Projects – Research oriented PG Projects by M.E. (Computer Engineering) and M.E.(Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering) students.
- Industrial Consultancy Work in the field of Embedded systems.
