International Educational Tour to Germany

1. Preamble and Introduction

The concept of International Educational Tour was in our minds for quite some time. The Institute Director Mr. Milind Tadvalkar and Managing Trustee Mr. Vishwas Deshpande were strongly thinking of carrying out such student visit that would provide our students with the global exposure. Therefore, when Redwood Edutours approached the institute with the Idea, it was accepted by the Institute after verifying the credentials of M/s Redwood Edutours.

2. Preparations



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














Process flow: Tracking an alumnus from alumni directory
