



Item 1.01: Discussion on executing the Applied Mathematics Semester III syllabus of Computer and Information Technology Engineering.

Item 1.02: Discussion on reference materials to be used in the teaching learning process.

Item 1.04: Deciding marks distribution to various modules in the revised syllabus

- The program was inaugurated at 1:30 p.m. in the presence of dignitaries on the dais, followed by a welcome speech and felicitation of resource person Dr. Nita Jain and Technical Advisor Dr. Sangeeta Joshi.
- In the first half of the Orientation Program, the syllabus revision in the branch
 of Computers was conducted by Prof. Ambadas Deshmukh followed by
 syllabus revision discussion for the branch of Information Technology by
 Dr. Nita Jain in the second half.
- The change in the syllabus was explained to all the University Mathematics fraternity and all inclusions and exclusions from the syllabus were discussed depending on the majority decision of the teachers. All welcomed the changes and agreed to a unanimous decision.
- 4. Participants were briefed about the conduct of Tutorial class as one credit is assigned to tutorial. Examples will be solved during the tutorial class and from these examples, 5 marks question in Term test 1 as well as Term test 2 will be asked. This provision has been initiated to justify the credit assigned to the tutorial. Total 8 tutorials (at least one on each module) will be conducted during the semester. File should be prepared for the tutorial work and students will be submitting the file at the end of the semester. If required, one or two week, this tutorial session may be converted into lecture session.

The approximate weightage for the Module 1 of Set Theory is decided as 19 marks with exclusion of extended Pigenhole principal.

[Chapter-1 (1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.6)]

 The approximate weightage for the Module 2 of Relation & Functions is decided as 19 marks including closure property of Relations and matrix representation of Relations.

[Chapter - 3 (3.1, 3.3, 3.4, 3.6, 3.7, 3.11, 3.12, 3.13, 3.14, 3.16)]

- The approximate weightage for the Module 3 of Laplace Transform is decided as 19 marks along with following points:
 - (i) Laplace transform of error function is to be considered as a content of the syllabus even though it is not specifically mentioned in the syllabus.
 - (ii) It has been unanimously discussed that no question will be asked in the end semester exam based on the proof of the properties of Laplace and Laplace of periodic function.
 - (iv) Heaviside unit step function and Dirac-delta function even though it is mentioned in the Module 3 of Laplace Transform, but examiner can ask question of Inverse Laplace Transform based on these special functions.
- The approximate weightage for the Module 4 of Inverse Laplace Transform is decided as 20 marks along with following points:
 - (i) First shifting property of Inverse Laplace transform is to be considered as a content of the syllabus even though it is not specifically mentioned in the syllabus.
 - (ii) Initially there were difference of opinions about solving of differential equation as an application of Laplace Transform. After a brief discussion, it has been unanimously decided that first order integro-differential equation, first order simultaneous system of differential equations (i.e. system of first order differential equations) and Higher order linear differential equations with constant coefficients (up to second order


differential equation)is to be considered for application of Laplace Transform.

- The approximate weightage for the Module 5 of Complex Variable & mapping is decided as 25 marks, along with following points:
 - (i) Proof of conversion of Cauchy-Riemann equation in polar form is to be considered but CR equations proof as necessary and sufficient condition will not be asked in end semester exam.
 - (ii) It has been discussed and decided that, questions based on checking analyticity of the function and standard results on analytic function are to be considered, whereas no question will be asked strictly on checking differentiability or continuity at point of analytic functions.
 - (iii) In the topic conformal mapping the transformation like, Translation, Magnification and rotation, Inversion and reflection are supposed to be introduced. None of the proof of the theorems will be asked in the end semester exam.
 - (iv) For Bilinear transformation proof of cross-ratio property will be considered and proof of fixed point theorem will be excluded.
- The approximate weightage for the Module 6 of Permutation, Combination & Probability is decided as 18 marks. [Chapter – 2 (2.1 to 2.8)]
- 11. It has been unanimously discussed to consider C. L. Liu and D. P. Mohapatra "Elements of Discrete mathematics", (text book sr. No. 5) as a reference for the changed modules for teaching the subject as well as paper setting.
- 12. After discussing the syllabus content in detail, it was suggested that while setting university question paper, compulsory question number 1 has to be set as per Bloom Taxonomy cognitive levels, and this question should be at lowest level so that every student will be in a position to attempt the same.

Program ended with vote of thanks given by program coordinator followed by distribution of attendance certificate at 5 pm.





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
Job Fair 2015 - 'Times Jobs in Association with VIT'
