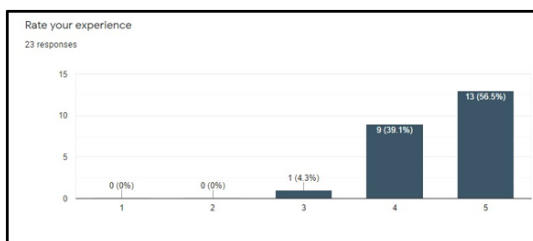

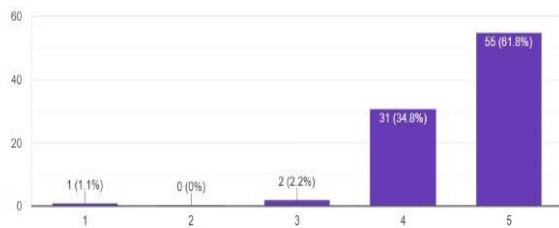
## ACM ACTIVITY: TECHTODAY
